The first language is improved.

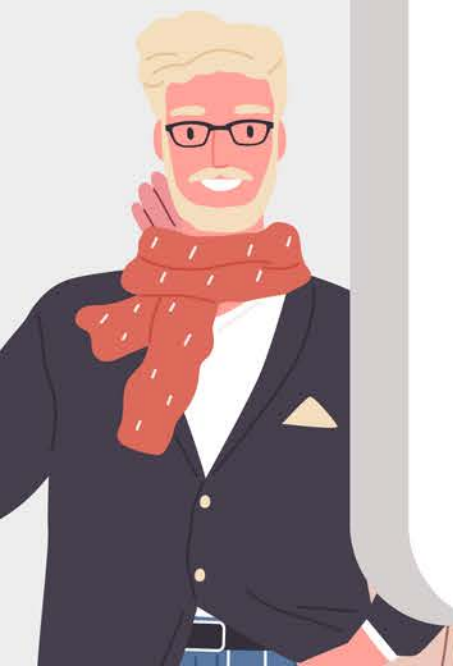

What is the World Language Academy?

It is a program where students with no previous language experience needed can take Spanish or French and receive High School credits starting in 7th and 8th grade in the chosen language. 6th grade is the introductory course for both languages.

The WL academy will help you be part of the multicultural society of today, being able to speak, listen, read, and write Spanish or French.

What is the World Language Academy?

If you are not zoned for Lakeview and want to be part of the World Language Academy, you can. You would just have to provide your own transportation to the school.

OCPs does not provide transportation to Magnet schools.

Selection is through the OCPs School Choice department and requirements include being at proficiency level on state assessments and at grade level in reading and math.

This is a lottery process.

WORLD LANGUAGE ACADEMY STRANDS

FOREIGN LANGUAGE ACADEMY

- no previous experience is needed in Spanish or French
- Current 8 graders earn 2 high school credits by the end of eighth grade.
- *Current 6th-7th graders will earn 3 credits by 8th grade

TWO-WAY DUAL LANGUAGE ACADEMY

- Students with previous experience in a dual language setting in the languages of Spanish and English.
- Earn 3 high school credits and possible college credits at the end of 8th grade, taking AP Spanish Course



World Language Academy as a 6th grader?

- They begin taking Spanish I or French I (depending on the language chosen) and no previous experience is necessary unless enrolling in the dual language academy.
- The student will continue in the program until 8th grade and receive their 1st Foreign language high school credit class in 7th grade (Spanish 2 or French 2) and 8th grade (Spanish 3 or French 3).
- They will have a cultural-language enrichment lab to expose them as much as possible to the language they selected using songs, games, art, and others. This class is offered for all three years of the program.

World Language Academy as a 6th grader?

- All *H.S.* credit courses will have end-of-the-year course exams that will grant them the credit. Common Final Exams (CFE) exams are provided by OCPs.
- Each foreign language class counts as an elective course every year.
- Students and parents will need to sign a contract at registration with the requirements and conditions of the program.

- Club offerings may happen before and after school.

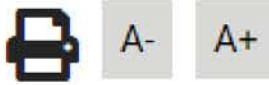

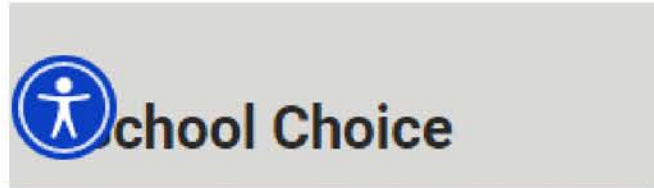

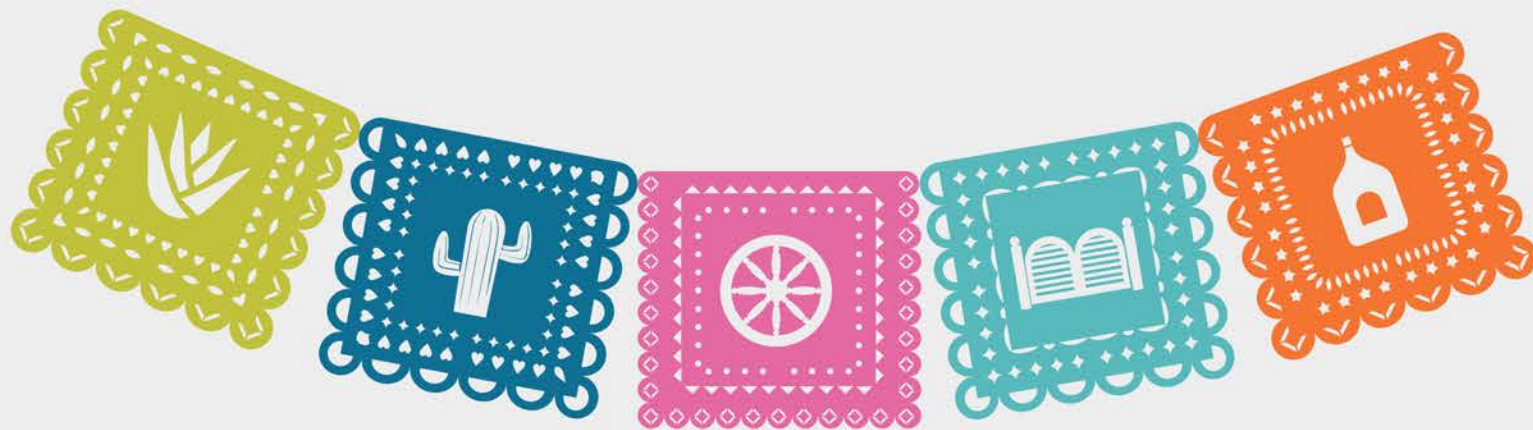
